Re: DIE Settlement Agreement

Dear Don:

This letter is to more fully elaborate on our understanding with respect to paragraph 2 of the above-referenced Settlement Agreement.

Paragraph 2 recognizes that under Section I.B.2 of the new Driver Selection, Orientation, Familiarization and Certification Manual., **local** management may change training sites. It is not intended, however, that Section I.B.2 will deprive the **motor** vehicle craft of the right to perform the work in accordance with the criteria in paragraph 1 of the Settlement Agreement. For instance, if the training is moved from a central location to another work site within the installation, such as a **Carrier Academy**, **motor** vehicle craft employees will be offered the opportunity to perform the work pursuant to paragraph 1.
