
This is an informational notice on the status of the Middlesex Essex, Massachusetts Area Mail Processing (AMP) feasibility study.

On August 20, you were notified of the Postal Service's intent to conduct an AMP study to determine whether efficiency could be increased by consolidating mail processing operations at the Middlesex Essex, Massachusetts Processing and Distribution Center with some operations performed at the Boston, Massachusetts Processing and Distribution Center. While conducting the study, the Postal Service determined that there are other factors associated with the Middlesex Essex Processing and Distribution Center or the community that need to be addressed before we can proceed with the study.

The study is on hold indefinitely. Should the Postal Service decide to resume this study, you will be notified.
