

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
RE: ONE-TIME RETIREMENT INCENTIVE**


QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS PART 2

1. May the expedited bidding process as described in No. 13 of the Q&A's dated September 4, 2009 (Part 1) be applied to Bulk Mail Clerk (SP2-44), Bulk Mail Technician (SP2-387), , Mail Classification Clerk (SP2-464), Mail Classification Clerk (SP2-465) Mailing Requirement Clerk (SP2-468), and Mail Requirements Clerk (SP2-469) positions?

Response: Yes. If too many employees in positions listed above at a particular location apply for the incentive, the Postal Service may invoke the expedited bidding process.

2. May training for positions listed above be done locally?

Response: Yes, the Postal Service has the discretion to provide the appropriate training locally even if it would otherwise be done at another location.
