

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE

AMERICAN POSTAL WORKERS UNION, AFL-CIO**

Re: Employee Reassignment/Work Issues Arising from Hurricane Katrina (Modification Regarding Voluntary Requests for Transfer)

The parties agree to remove the current language in Section 2.g of the Memorandum of Understanding dated September 27, 2005, Re: Employee Reassignment/Work Issues Arising from Hurricane Katrina and replace with the following paragraph:

Any impacted employee, as defined in the September 27, 2005 Memorandum of Understanding, who voluntarily transfers under section 2 will receive bargaining unit relocation expenses consistent with Article 12 Section 5.B.5 of the National Agreement.

This Memorandum of Understanding does not set a precedent for any purpose, and may be cited in this and other forums only to enforce its terms.
