This letter is an informational notice of the status of the U.S. Postal Service's Area Mail Processing (AMP) study of the Kinston originating mail processing operations at the Kinston Processing & Distribution Facility (P&DF).

In the fall of 2005, an AMP plan was initially approved to move some mail processing operations from the Kinston P&DF to the Fayetteville Processing & Distribution Center. With a subsequent change in management in 2006, that plan was reviewed again, and a decision was made to not implement the approved plan.
