Dear Mr. Vegliante:

This is to inquire about the policy of the United States Postal Service permitting Highway Contract Route (HCR) employers to stage and store private equipment on postal property.

This issue has been brought to the attention of local managers without resolution, allegedly because there are no national guidelines.

Permitting the staging and storing of private equipment on postal property raises a number of issues relative to liability, safety and conformance with contractual terms.

I request an explanation of USPS policy on this issue for my review, and appropriate response.
