Ballot Deadline Extended

Based on the results of an investigation conducted by the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Labor-Management Standards (OLMS), the American Postal Workers Union (APWU) entered into a settlement agreement with OLMS on June 12, 2008. APWU has agreed to rerun, under OLMS supervision, the Motor Vehicle Division National Business Agent, Southern Region, Southwest Sub-Region.

Due to the situation in Texas and Louisiana, the deadline to return ballots in the election of the National Business Agent, Southern Region, Southwest Sub-Region has been extended to Wednesday, October 15, 2008 at 10:45 A.M. (EST).

You may request a duplicate ballot for the National Business Agent, Southern Region, Southwest Sub-Region election if you have not yet received your ballot or your ballot was destroyed or lost.

Any Motor Vehicle Division member who has not received a ballot or whose ballot was destroyed or lost should notify Election Supervisor Erica Weber by calling (202) 513-7306, faxing (202) 513-7301, or writing to 800 North Capitol Street, NW, Suite 120, Washington, D.C. 20002-4244. The member requesting the duplicate ballot should CLEARLY provide his/her name, the last four digits of his/her social security number, local number, phone number, and a mailing address where he/she can receive the duplicate ballot.

**Ballots are now due back no later than
10:45 A.M. (EST) on October 15, 2008.**

Any member may protest the supervised election for valid cause; such protest should be made directly to the Election Supervisor in writing as soon as possible, but no later than 10 days after the election to 800 North Capitol Street, NW, Suite 120, Washington, D.C. 20002-4244; fax (202) 513-7301. The OLMS protest procedures are in lieu of the APWU election protest procedures set forth in the APWU Constitution and Bylaws, dated August 18, 2006.
