

Every two weeks the USPS puts out the latest RIBBS Report which is an update on the 81 facilities that have been on the Consolidation/Closure List since 2013.

Instructions for getting the Updated RIBBS Report:

Go on the Internet USPSliteblue.gov

You must be an Active Employee and utilize your EIN and password.

Spread Sheet explains what kind of mail is effected across the top

Blue color N/A not applicable

Green Color C completed

Green with Date date the mail moved or date it will be moved

Yellow TBD “To Be Determined”
