

Your Post Office Receives **Zero Tax Dollars**

FACT: The United States Postal Service is funded entirely by the sale of stamps, money orders and postal products.

FACT: The Postal Service is not broke! Based on its operations, it had a surplus of \$1.1 billion in the first quarter of fiscal year 2015, \$1.4 billion in fiscal year 2014, and \$600 million in fiscal year 2013.

Congress has been using the Postal Service as a cash cow for years. It's time for Congress to stop draining the Postal Service of funds and allow the Postal Service to fulfill its mandate to provide prompt and efficient service to all Americans.

The American Postal Workers Union is negotiating a new contract with the Postal Service. The union is demanding that postal management stop delaying America's mail by discontinuing the closure and "consolidation" of 82 mail processing centers. The union is demanding that the Postal Service reverse a reduction in service standards management implemented on Jan. 5, which has caused disastrous delays in your mail. The union is demanding that the Postal Service provide you with expanded hours of service, shorter wait time in line, and new services, such as non-profit postal banking.
