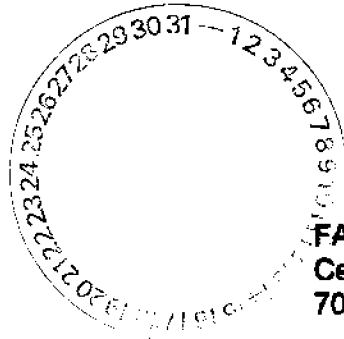

RE: Area Mail Processing (AMP) Feasibility Survey

Dear Bill:

As a matter of general information, it is the intent of the U. S. Postal Service to conduct an Area Mail Processing (AMP) survey for the feasibility of consolidating certain mail processing operations at the following locations:

- Alamogordo, NM Post Office into EL Paso, TX Processing & Distribution Center (P&DC);
- McAllen, TX Post Office into Corpus Christi Processing & Distribution Facility (P&DF);
- Waco, TX Processing & Distribution Facility (P&DF) into Fort Worth, TX Processing & Distribution Center (P&DC) and Austin, TX Processing & Distribution Center (P&DC);
- Bryan, TX Post Office into Houston, TX Processing & Distribution Center (P&DC);
- Cumberland, MD Main Post Office into Frederick, MD Processing & Distribution Facility (P&DF).

The reason for the survey is to address the shifting mail volume and the need to manage capacity needs while improving efficiency.

This letter is solely intended to provide you with information that we plan to conduct the study. The study results will be analyzed and a decision will then be made. This letter is not intended as notice of future changes in mail processing, and is not a notice of affect on employees. You will be provided with the appropriate contractual notice, if any is required, when a decision is made on the survey results.
