

This is to advise you of the intent of the San Diego District to utilize the provisions of Article 12.5.C.5 to involuntarily reassign up to five (5) full-time Level 6 clerks and two (2) part-time regular clerks from the craft and/or installation at four (4) separate offices. The basis of this action are Function 4 administrative Staffing and Scheduling Reviews. The specifics as to the number of impacted clerks in each office can be found below:

The impacted clerks will be notified of their involuntary reassignments by separate letter. The placement process would normally not begin before April 27 2011; however, the loss of workload nationally and the financials of the Postal Service may make it necessary to begin the placement process in advance of that date. It may also be necessary to utilize the provisions of Article 7.2.B of the National Agreement to detail some or all of the impact clerks during the notice period in order to provide them with a work opportunity.

By copy of this notice, we are authorizing the withholding of up to five (5) full-time residual assignments and two part-time regular residual assignments in the clerk, carrier, mail handler and custodial crafts in plants and post offices within a 900 mile radius of the impacted sites based on this impact.

Attached for your review are copies of the automated impact statements (AIR), the operational data supporting the need to excess and a seniority lists identifying the impacted clerks in each office...
