We were able to resolve majority of your concerns as follows:

- The two APWU Bulletin boards were returned to the living Quarters Area immediately.
- New POP Corn Machines will be delivered soon.
- Food Temperature will be monitored daily, if not you are encouraged to contact the Kitchen Manager immediately.
- APBS is in the process of being separated to Basic and Advance courses.
- Soda and Coffee machines were moved inside Buffet area not eliminated.
- Beds replacement are on a cycle and are being looked into, feedback forth coming.
- NST related issues were discussed regarding Overtime and Holidays scheduling, including Time Zone (ongoing discussions).
